\*Jullie = you plural, so when you're talking to more than one colleague

\*\*Je = you singular, so when you're talking to just one colleague

I used the informal "je" for "you" in Dutch. We have a formal "u" as well, but it isn't often used with colleagues, not even your boss / manager (but that depends, so always double check with your colleagues).
